

GRASP Community College Scholarship Application

Earn your associate degree or career certification at a Virginia Community College

All completed applications must be emailed to the GRASP office or postmarked by Monday, April 15th. Only complete application packets will be considered.

GRASP will award scholarships to selected applicants for \$1,000 for their first year of community college. Scholarships may be renewed for a second year of the program.

Eligible scholarship recipients will enroll at a **Virginia Community College** to either complete a career certificate or with the intent to transfer to a Virginia four-year public or private institution through Virginia's Guaranteed Admission Agreement.

STUDENTS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY

- Have met with the high school GRASP advisor to establish a post-secondary plan
- Possess at least a 2.0 cumulative high school grade point average
- Will graduate from high school spring of 2024
- Have filed a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) or the Virginia Alternative State Aid (VASA) application
- Have financial need as determined by the FAFSA or VASA
- Plan to enroll at a Virginia Community College either to complete a career certificate or with the intent to transfer to a Virginia four-year public or private institution. FOUR APPLICATION PARTS

A complete application packet has four parts:

1. A GRASP scholarship application, including essay.
2. A complete copy of the FAFSA Submission Summary (SAI). The Summary can be reprinted by going to www.fafsa.ed.gov. Or a statement that the VASA has been completed.
3. Selection of community college AND 4-year school you intend to transfer to on the College Selection Form
OR Indicate the Career Certificate you intend to earn.

HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

To submit your scholarship application, go to www.grasp4va.org/scholarships. Download the application from the scholarships page by clicking **GRASP Community College Scholarship**. This will allow you to complete the application as a fillable PDF form. Save the form, then either print it out and mail it with a copy of your FAFSA Submission Summary **OR** email the scanned copy of your signed application and FAFSA Student Submission Summary to scholarships@grasp4va.org. Partial applications will not be considered.
